Shin-Horng Chen is currently the Director and a research fellow of the International Division at the Chung-Hua Institution for Economic Research in Taipei, Taiwan. Apart from full-time research work, Dr. Chen has taught on a part-time base at a few local universities in Taiwan, including National Taiwan University, National Chiao Tung University, National Tsing Hua University, and National Central University. His early professional experience includes research assistantship at the Centre for Urban and Regional Development Studies (CURDS) at Newcastle University, UK (1993-1995), and the Industrial Economics Research Center at the Industrial Technology Research Institute (ITRI), Taipei (1987-1989).

Dr. Chen has intensive research experiences on the development of the ICT industry, science and technology policy, national innovation system, global production and innovation networks, R&D internationalization, and industrial clusters. Recently he has extended his research fields into technology branding, technology foresight, and service innovation. His major publications can be found in such academic journals as *Research Policy*, *R&D management*, *China Information* and *NTU Management Review*, and a few editorial books.

He received B.A. and M.A degrees in Economics from National Taiwan University, and Ph.D. under the ICT Programme from University of Newcastle upon Tyne, UK, in 1994, jointly supervised by Professors Jeremy Howells and Alfred Thwaites.
